- 4 enjoyment of reading, viewing and listening; and
- 5 WHEREAS, School libraries also provide Pennsylvania's
- 6 children with access to information and technology within the
- 7 school and links to resources outside the school; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Promoting competency in new and developing
- 9 technology is an integral part of school library programs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Navigating evolving information and technology is
- 11 necessary to successfully complete tasks vital to having a
- 12 career and succeeding in life; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Librarians play a vital role in teaching students to
- 14 become effective users of information and ideas; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Twenty-five states have conducted studies showing
- 16 that students who attend schools with certified librarians score
- 17 better on reading and writing tests than students in schools
