A RESOLUTION

Observing September 15 through October 15, 2018, as "Hispanic Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania and recognizing the achievements of Hispanic Americans in our Commonwealth. WHEREAS, Hispanics have contributed significantly to the extraordinary diversity and progress of our Commonwealth and our nation; and

WHEREAS, Hispanics represent the fastest-growing minority ethnic group in our Commonwealth and our nation; and WHEREAS, With a median age of 27, Hispanics comprise the youngest minority ethnic group in the United States; and WHEREAS, An average of 900,000 young persons of Hispanic origin are projected to become eligible to vote each year through 2028; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's ethnically diverse population features more than 800,000 Hispanic residents, including persons of Puerto Rican, Mexican and Dominican descent; and WHEREAS, With roots in Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean, Central America and South America, Hispanic Americans culturally enrich
