AN ACT

Amending the act of August 23, 1961 (P.L.1068, No.484), entitled "An act to provide for the creation and administration of a Coal and Clay Mine Subsidence Insurance Fund within the 3 Department of Environmental Protection for the insurance of compensation for damages to subscribers thereto; declaring 5 false oaths by the subscribers to be misdemeanors; providing 6 penalties for the violation thereof; and making an 7 appropriation," further providing for application for 8 insurance, terms of insurance, penalty for false statement 9 and list of mining areas. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 12 of the act of August 23, 1961 14 (P.L.1068, No.484), entitled "An act to provide for the creation 15 and administration of a Coal and Clay Mine Subsidence Insurance Fund within the Department of Environmental Protection for the 16 17 insurance of compensation for damages to subscribers thereto; 18 declaring false oaths by the subscribers to be misdemeanors; 19 providing penalties for the violation thereof; and making an 20 appropriation," is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 12. Application for Insurance; Terms of Insurance;

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- 1 Penalty for False Statement; List of Mining Areas. --* * *
- 2 (a.1) A broker acting on behalf of a seller, financial
- 3 institution issuing the mortgage for the property and the seller
- 4 of a structure located within an anthracite or bituminous coal
- 5 or clay mine region shall conspicuously make the purchaser aware
- 6 of the existence of the subsidence insurance offered under this
- 7 <u>act. As used in this subsection, the term "broker" shall have</u>
- 8 the same meaning as in section 201 of the act of February 19,
- 9 1980 (P.L.15, No.9), known as the "Real Estate Licensing and
- 10 Registration Act."

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
