AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers 5 thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 6 7 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 10 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for judicial 17 administration; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined," in powers and duties of the 21 Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs, further providing 22 23 for powers and duties. 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows: 26 Section 1. Section 2301-A of the act of April 9, 1929

(P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is

- 9 <u>length of care, including hospital detoxification, for all</u>
- 10 patients receiving drug and alcohol addiction treatment
- 11 through Federal or State funding.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
