- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- § 4304.1. Duty to report disappearance of child.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A parent of a child under 14 years of
- age commits an offense if the parent, with reckless disregard 11
- for the risk of harm to the child or for the health, safety or 12
- welfare of the child, fails to report the disappearance of the 13
- child to a law enforcement agency. 14
- 15 (b) Grading. -- An offense under subsection (a) constitutes a
- 16 felony of the third degree.
- 17 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 18 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- 1 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 2 "Disappearance." An instance in which the whereabouts of the
- 3 child are unknown to the parent for more than 24 hours.
- 4 "Parent." A natural parent, stepparent, adoptive parent,
- 5 <u>quardian or custodian of a child.</u>
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
