AN ACT

- 1 Providing for a detoxification and addiction treatment bed 2 registry.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 7 Detoxification and Addiction Treatment Bed Registry Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Bed registry." The detoxification and addiction treatment
- 13 bed registry established under section 3.
- 14 "Department." The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs of
- 15 the Commonwealth.
- 16 "Licensed provider." A hospital-based detoxification or
- 17 rehabilitation treatment program licensed to provide care for

- 1 substance use disorders or a licensed nonhospital residential
- 2 detoxification facility.
- 3 Section 3. Registry.
- 4 (a) Development. -- The department shall develop and
- 5 administer an Internet-based detoxification and addiction
- 6 treatment bed registry to collect, aggregate and display
- 7 information about available beds at a licensed provider's
- 8 facility for the treatment of individuals in need of
- 9 detoxification and addiction treatment.
- 10 (b) Contents. -- The bed registry shall include, but not be
- 11 limited to, the following:
- 12 (1) Descriptive information for licensed providers in
- this Commonwealth, including contact information for each
- 14 licensed provider.
- 15 (2) Real-time information updated at least daily
- regarding the number of beds available at a licensed
- 17 provider's facility and, for each available bed, the type of
- 18 patient that may be admitted, the level of security provided
- 19 and other information that may be necessary to allow for the
- 20 identification of appropriate licensed providers for the
- 21 treatment of individuals in need of detoxification and
- 22 addiction treatment.
- 23 (3) A search function to identify available beds that
- 24 are appropriate for the treatment of individuals experiencing
- 25 a substance abuse emergency.
- 26 (c) Participation requirement. -- A licensed provider shall
- 27 participate in the bed registry established under this section
- 28 and shall designate an employee to report information for
- 29 inclusion in the bed registry. The designated employee shall
- 30 serve as a point of contact for addressing requests for

- 1 information related to data reported on the bed registry. The
- 2 designated employee shall be responsible for updating
- 3 information on the bed registry as required under subsection (b)
- 4 (2).
- 5 (d) Licensed provider requirements. -- In order to be eligible
- 6 to access the bed registry, a licensed provider shall:
- 7 (1) submit the information specified under subsection
- 8 (b) to the bed registry, including providing daily real-time
- 9 information under subsection (b)(2); or
- 10 (2) arrange for the licensed provider's contact
- information to be monitored and accessed at any time in
- 12 accordance with the department's regulations promulgated
- 13 under section 4.
- 14 (e) Private contracting. -- The department may enter into a
- 15 contract with a private entity for the development and
- 16 administration of the bed registry.
- 17 Section 4. Regulations.
- 18 The department shall promulgate regulations necessary to
- 19 implement this act.
- 20 Section 5. Effective date.
- 21 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
