## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 7, 1961 (P.L.518, No.268), entitled "An act to create a regional agency by intergovernmental compact 2 for the planning, conservation, utilization, development, 3 management and control of the water and related natural 4 resources of the Delaware River Basin, for the improvement of 5 navigation, reduction of flood damage, regulation of water 6 7 quality, control of pollution, development of water supply, hydroelectric energy, fish and wildlife habitat and public 8 recreational facilities, and other purposes, and defining the 9 functions, powers and duties of such agency," in pollution 10 control, further providing for enforcement; and, in general 11 provisions, further providing for effect on riparian rights. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Sections 5.4 of Article 5 and 14.19 of Article 14 in Part I of section 1 of the act of July 7, 1961 (P.L.518, 16 17 No.268), known as the Delaware River Basin Compact, are amended 18 to read: 19 Section 1. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby solemnly 20 covenants and agrees with the states of Delaware, New Jersey and New York and the United States of America, upon the enactment of 21

- 2 by the respective state legislatures, as follows:

- 9 Section 5.4. Enforcement. [The] Except for matters relating
- 10 to on-lot septic systems, the commission may, after
- 11 investigation and hearing, issue an order or orders upon any
- 12 person or public or private corporation, or other entity, to
- 13 cease the discharge of sewage, industrial or other waste into
- 14 waters of the basin which it determines to be in violation of
- 15 such rules and regulations as it shall have adopted for the
- 16 prevention and abatement of pollution. Any such order or orders
- 17 may prescribe the date, including a reasonable time for the
- 18 construction of any necessary works, on or before which such
- 19 discharge shall be wholly or partially discontinued, modified or
- 20 treated, or otherwise conformed to the requirements of such
- 21 rules and regulations. Such order shall be reviewable in any
- 22 court of competent jurisdiction. The courts of the signatory
- 23 parties shall have jurisdiction to enforce against any person,
- 24 public or private corporation, or other entity, any and all
- 25 provisions of this article or of any such order. The commission
- 26 may bring an action in its own name in any such court of
- 27 competent jurisdiction to compel compliance with any provision
- 28 of this article, or any rule or regulation issued pursuant
- 29 thereto or of any such order, according to the practice and
- 30 procedure of the court. <u>In matters relating to on-lot septic</u>

- 1 systems, the commission may report its investigation findings to
- 2 the water pollution abatement agencies of the signatory parties.

- 5 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 7 Section 14.19. Effect on Riparian Rights or On-Lot Septic
- 8 Systems. Nothing contained in this compact shall be construed as
- 9 affecting or intending to affect or in any way to interfere with
- 10 the law of the respective signatory parties relating to riparian
- 11 rights or on-lot septic systems.

- 13 Section 2. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall cause
- 14 publication of a notice in the Pennsylvania Bulletin upon
- 15 enactment of legislation having an identical effect as section 1
- 16 of this act by the Congress of the United States and the states
- 17 of Delaware, New Jersey and New York.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
- 19 (1) Section 1 of this act shall take effect upon
- 20 publication of the notice required by section 2 of this act.
- 21 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect
- 22 immediately.
