## AN ACT

Amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions, providing 2 for Abandoned Manufacturing Sites Registry. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. - 7 This subchapter relates to the Abandoned Manufacturing Sites

- 9 § 902. Definitions.
- The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- "Abandoned manufacturing site." Real property:
- 14 (1) The expansion, redevelopment or reuse of which may
- involve remediation to contain, neutralize or remove a
- 16 <u>hazardous substance</u>, pollutant or contaminant resulting from
- 17 previous use of the property.
- 18 (2) That has been abandoned and the property owner has
- 19 given up dominion or that is vacant.
- 20 (3) That may be listed as a brownfield site in the Small
- 21 <u>Business Liability Relief and Brownfields Revitalization Act</u>
- 22 (Public Law 107-118, 115 Stat. 2356), or involved in
- remediation under the act of May 19, 1995 (P.L.4, No.2),
- known as the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation
- 25 Standards Act.
- 26 (4) Located in an economic cluster, including one of the
- 27 <u>following energy-driven sectors:</u>
- (i) petrochemicals;
- 29 <u>(ii) advanced materials; or</u>
- 30 (iii) data-driven manufacturing.

- 1 (5) For which cleaning up and reinvesting may improve
- the environment, reduce blight and remove development
- 3 <u>pressures on green spaces.</u>
- 4 "ADVANCED MATERIALS." MANUFACTURING SEGMENTS SUCH AS GLASS, <--
- 5 CEMENT, STEEL, ALUMINUM, ADVANCED GLASS AND FIBER COMPONENTS FOR
- 6 ELECTRONICS AND CONSUMER MEDIA DEVICES AND ADVANCED CONSTRUCTION
- 7 MATERIALS SUCH AS LIGHTWEIGHT CONCRETE, RECYCLED PLASTICS, HIGH-
- 8 <u>STRENGTH METALS AND NANOFIBERS.</u>
- 9 "DATA-DRIVEN MANUFACTURING." THE USE OF ANALYTICS, AI AND
- 10 ROBOTICS FOR DATA CENTERS AND FABRICATED MATERIALS, COMPONENTS
- 11 AND ADDITIVE MATERIALS MANUFACTURING.
- 12 "Department." The Department of Community and Economic
- 13 <u>Development of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 14 "Registry." The Abandoned Manufacturing Sites Registry
- 15 <u>established in this chapter.</u>
- 16 § 903. Abandoned Manufacturing Sites Registry.
- 17 (a) Establishment. -- The Abandoned Manufacturing Sites
- 18 Registry is established. The department, OR A THIRD-PARTY ENTITY <--
- 19 WITH WHICH THE DEPARTMENT HAS AN AGREEMENT, shall implement and
- 20 administer the registry in accordance with this chapter.
- 21 (b) Purpose. -- The registry shall contain a list of abandoned
- 22 manufacturing sites.
- 23 (c) Information included. -- The registry shall include the
- 24 following information for each abandoned manufacturing site:
- 25 (1) The name and contact information of the current
- owner of the abandoned manufacturing site.
- 27 (2) The legal description of the abandoned manufacturing
- 28 site.
- 29 (3) A current description of the condition of the real
- 30 property and a note as to whether the property is a

- 1 <u>brownfield site as defined in the Small Business Liability</u>
- 2 Relief and Brownfields Revitalization Act (Public Law 107-
- 3 118, 115 Stat. 2356), or involved in the act of May 19, 1995
- 4 (P.L.4, No.2), known as the Land Recycling and Environmental
- 5 Remediation Standards Act.
- 6 (D) REQUIREMENT.--ALL ABANDONED MANUFACTURING SITES OWNED BY <--
- 7 THE COMMONWEALTH OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL BE LISTED ON
- 8 THE REGISTRY WITHIN 60 DAYS OF VACANCY.
- 9 (E) REPORT.--ON OR BEFORE THE SECOND MARCH 30 OF THE
- 10 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, AND EVERY SUBSEQUENT MARCH 30
- 11 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE
- 12 CHAIRPERSON AND MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMUNITY, ECONOMIC
- 13 AND RECREATIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE, THE
- 14 CHAIRPERSON AND MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMERCE COMMITTEE
- 15 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED
- 16 TO:
- 17 (1) THE NUMBER OF PROPERTIES, BY COUNTY, ON THE REGISTRY
- 18 DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR;
- 19 (2) THE NUMBER OF TIMES THE REGISTRY HAS BEEN ACCESSED
- 20 <u>IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR;</u>
- 21 (3) ANY PERCEIVED ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE PRIOR YEAR;
- 22 (4) THE PLANS FOR THE UPCOMING YEAR TO IMPROVE PROCESSES
- 23 AND PROCEDURES; AND
- 24 (5) ANY DIFFICULTIES IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
- 25 <u>REGISTRY EXPERIENCED.</u>
- 26 § 904. Departmental duties.
- 27 The department shall:
- 28 (1) ESTABLISH INFORMATION SHARING PROCEDURES FOR LOCAL <--
- 29 GOVERNMENTS, REGIONAL CHAMBERS OF COMMERCE, LOCAL ECONOMIC
- 30 DEVELOPMENT ENTITIES AND OTHER RELEVANT ORGANIZATIONS TO

2	(RELATING TO ABANDONED MANUFACTURING SITES REGISTRY).	
3	(1) (2) Establish procedures for the completeness and	<
4	accuracy of information in the registry.	
5	(2) (3) Keep an updated registry database on the	<
6	department's publicly accessible Internet website. The	
7	registry shall be clearly defined on and easily navigable	
8	from the department's publicly accessible Internet website.	
9	(3) Promulgate regulations necessary to carry out the	<
10	department's duty to maintain the registry.	
11	§ 905. Fees prohibited.	
12	The department may not assess a fee for the dissemination of	
13	registry information to Internet users.
