- suspension," providing for licensure by endorsement. 8
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. The act of July 2, 1993 (P.L.345, No.48),
- 12 entitled "An act empowering the General Counsel or his designee
- 13 to issue subpoenas for certain licensing board activities;
- 14 providing for hearing examiners in the Bureau of Professional
- 15 and Occupational Affairs; providing additional powers to the
- 16 Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs; and
- 17 further providing for civil penalties and license suspension,"
- is amended by adding a section to read: 18
- Section 6.1. Licensure by endorsement. 19

- 1 (a) General rule. -- A NOTWITHSTANDING ANY EXISTING PROVISIONS <--
- 2 RELATED TO LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT OR LICENSURE BY RECIPROCITY
- 3 IN ANY APPLICABLE LICENSING STATUTE, A licensing board or
- 4 <u>commission shall issue a license, certificate, registration or</u>
- 5 permit to an applicant to allow practice in this Commonwealth
- 6 if, upon application to the licensing board, the applicant
- 7 <u>satisfies all of the following conditions:</u>
- 8 <u>(1) Holds a current license, certificate, registration</u>
- 9 <u>or permit from another state, territory or country and the</u>
- licensing board or commission determines that state's,
- 11 <u>territory's or country's requirements are substantially</u>
- 12 <u>equivalent to or exceed the requirements established in this</u>
- 13 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 14 (2) Demonstrates competency in the profession or
- occupation through methods determined by the licensing board
- or commission, including having completed continuing
- 17 education or having experience in the professional or
- 18 occupation for at least two of the five years preceding the
- date of the application under this section.
- 20 (3) Has not committed any act that would have <--
- 21 <u>constituted CONSTITUTES grounds for refusal, suspension or</u>
- 22 revocation of a license, registration, certificate or permit
- 23 to practice that profession or occupation in this
- 24 Commonwealth at the time the act was committed. UNLESS THE <-
- 25 LICENSING BOARD OR COMMISSION DETERMINES, IN ITS DISCRETION,
- 26 THAT THE ACT SHOULD NOT BE AN IMPEDIMENT TO THE GRANTING OF A
- 27 LICENSE, REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATE OR PERMIT TO PRACTICE IN
- THIS COMMONWEALTH.
- 29 (4) Is in good standing and has not been disciplined by
- 30 the jurisdiction that issued the license, registration,

- 1 certificate or permit- UNLESS THE LICENSING BOARD OR
- 2 COMMISSION DETERMINES, IN ITS DISCRETION, THAT THE DISCIPLINE

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- 3 SHOULD NOT BE AN IMPEDIMENT TO THE GRANTING OF A LICENSE,
- 4 REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATE OR PERMIT TO PRACTICE IN THIS
- 5 COMMONWEALTH.
- 6 (5) Pays any fees established by the licensing board or
- 7 <u>commission by regulation.</u>
- 8 (b) Provisional endorsement license. -- A licensing board or
- 9 <u>commission may issue a provisional license, registration,</u>
- 10 certificate or permit to an applicant for licensure by
- 11 endorsement while the applicant is satisfying remaining
- 12 <u>requirements for the licensure by endorsement as determined by</u>
- 13 the board. The holder of a provisional endorsement license
- 14 <u>issued under this subsection may practice until any of the</u>
- 15 <u>following occurs:</u>
- 16 (1) A license, registration, certificate or permit is
- 17 granted or denied by the licensing board or commission under <--
- 18 this section.
- 19 (2) The expiration of the provisional endorsement
- license as established by the board by regulation.
- 21 (3) The holder of the provisional endorsement license
- fails to comply with the terms of the provisional license.
- 23 (C) CONSTRUCTION.--NOTHING IN THIS SECTION IS INTENDED TO <--
- 24 SUPERSEDE OR REPLACE EXISTING STATUTORY PROVISIONS RELATING TO
- 25 LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT OR LICENSURE BY RECIPROCITY APPLICABLE
- 26 TO LICENSING BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS THROUGH THEIR RESPECTIVE
- 27 ENABLING STATUTES.
- 28 Section 2. Final regulations shall be promulgated by each
- 29 licensing board and commission within 18 months of the effective
- 30 date of this act.

1 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
