AN ACT

- Designating the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 18676, on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 747 over the Juniata River in
- Mount Union Borough, Huntingdon County, as the Captain Joseph
- 4 S. Giacobello Memorial Bridge.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Captain Joseph S. Giacobello Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) Joseph S. Giacobello lived a life of humble service
- 11 to the residents of Mount Union and to the nation.
- 12 (2) Born June 30, 1919, Mr. Giacobello attended Mount
- 13 Union High School, from which he graduated in 1938.
- 14 (3) Mr. Giacobello attended Shippensburg State Teachers
- 15 College, where he was a standout basketball and football
- 16 player until he was drafted into the United States Army in
- 17 1942.
- 18 (4) Mr. Giacobello was assigned to the United States

- 1 Army infantry. He completed his basic training at Camp
- 2 Pickett in Virginia and then attended Officer Candidate
- 3 School at Fort Benning, Georgia.
- 4 (5) Mr. Giacobello was deployed to the European Theater
- 5 with the 35th Infantry Division, Co. F, 2nd Battalion, 137th
- 6 Infantry Regiment, arriving in Normandy, France, on July 5,
- 7 1944, and activated into combat on July 11, 1944, in the
- 8 fighting in the hedgerows of St. Lo, France.
- 9 (6) In one of many distinguished combat actions, Mr.
- 10 Giacobello heroically led his company in an attack on the
- 11 French village of Hellimer, where he and two others stopped a
- machine gun and knocked out a Panther tank, saving what many
- 13 believe are countless lives.
- 14 (7) Mr. Giacobello was one of the most highly decorated
- soldiers in central Pennsylvania earning the Distinguished
- Service Cross, two Silver Stars, two Purple Hearts and the
- 17 Combat Infantryman Badge while fighting in combat in the
- 18 European Theater.
- 19 (8) Mr. Giacobello attained the rank of Captain in the
- 20 United States Army during his time in combat and service to
- 21 our nation.
- 22 (9) Upon returning home, Mr. Giacobello dedicated his
- life to service in his Mount Union community where he helped
- 24 countless local veterans and supported youth sports
- 25 activities.
- 26 (10) Mr. Giacobello passed away on February 16, 2019.
- 27 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 28 18676, located on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 747 in
- 29 Mount Union Borough, Huntingdon County, over the Juniata River
- 30 is designated the Captain Joseph S. Giacobello Memorial Bridge.

- 1 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 2 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 3 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 4 Section 2. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
