- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 13A03 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 8 § 13A03. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 10 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 13 <u>"Campaign consultant." A person that receives compensation</u>
- 14 <u>for campaign-related professional services rendered to a</u>
- 15 <u>campaign to elect an individual to office.</u>

- 17 Section 2. Section 13A07(f)(1) of Title 65 is amended by
- 18 adding a subparagraph to read:

1 § 13A07. Prohibited activities.

3 (f) Unlawful acts.--

4 (1) A lobbyist or principal may not:

5 * * *

6 (xi) Engage in lobbying a State official or a State
7 employee on the State official's staff after serving as a
8 campaign consultant for the State official or after
9 having a pecuniary interest in a campaign consultant that
10 rendered campaign consulting services for the State
11 official. This prohibition shall only apply for the term
12 in which the State official was elected and for which the

campaign consulting services were provided.
