## AN ACT

Amending Title 8 (Boroughs and Incorporated Towns) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and duties of 2 elected officials, further providing for organization of 3 council, quorum, participation by telecommunication device, 4 voting, compensation and eligibility; and, in mayor, further 5 providing for salary of mayor. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1001(e) of Title 8 of the Pennsylvania 10 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 11 12 § 1001. Organization of council, quorum, participation by 13 telecommunication device, voting, compensation and 14 eligibility. 15 16 (e) Compensation. -- Members of council may receive 17 compensation to be fixed by ordinance as follows: 18 In boroughs with a population of less than 5,000, a maximum of [\$1,875] \$3,145 per year. 19 20 In boroughs with a population of 5,000 or more but (2)

- less than 10,000, a maximum of [\$2,500] \$4,190 per year.
- 2 (3) In boroughs with a population of 10,000 or more but
- 3 less than 15,000, a maximum of [\$3,250] \$5,450 per year.
- 4 (4) In boroughs with a population of 15,000 or more but
- 5 less than 25,000, a maximum of [\$4,125] \$6,915 per year.
- 6 (5) In boroughs with a population of 25,000 or more but
- 7 less than 35,000, a maximum of [\$4,375] \$7,335 per year.
- 8 (6) In boroughs with a population of 35,000 or more, a
- 9 maximum of [\$5,000] <u>\$8,385</u> per year.
- 10 The salaries shall be payable monthly or quarterly for the
- 11 duties imposed by this part. Benefits provided to members of
- 12 council under section 1202(26) (relating to specific powers)
- 13 shall not be considered pay, salary or compensation, but payment
- 14 for all or a part of the premiums or charges for the benefits
- 15 shall be in accordance with section 1202(26). Any change in
- 16 salary, compensation or emoluments of the elected office shall
- 17 become effective at the beginning of the next term of the member
- 18 of council.
- 19 <u>(e.1) Alternative compensation. -- Notwithstanding subsection</u>
- 20 (e), the council may provide that members of council shall
- 21 receive compensation on a per-meeting basis based on attendance
- 22 <u>of members of council. Total annual compensation may not exceed</u>
- 23 the amounts specified in subsection (e). Compensation shall only
- 24 be payable for duly advertised public meetings in which a member
- 25 of council participated. If the council has provided that
- 26 members of council shall receive compensation on a per-meeting
- 27 basis, the council may provide for the forfeiture of up to 1/12
- 28 of the annual compensation of a member of council or impose
- 29 another appropriate penalty for each unexcused absence from a
- 30 regularly scheduled meeting.

- 2 Section 2. Section 10A04(a) of Title 8 is amended to read:
- 3 § 10A04. Salary of mayor.
- 4 (a) General rule. -- The salary of the mayor shall be
- 5 established by ordinance and shall not exceed the following:
- 6 (1) In a borough with a population of less than 5,000, a
- 7 maximum of [\$2,500] \$4,190 per year.
- 8 (2) In a borough with a population of 5,000 or more but
- 9 less than 10,000, a maximum of [\$5,000]  $\frac{\$8,385}{}$  per year.
- 10 (3) In a borough with a population of 10,000 or more but
- less than 15,000, a maximum of [\$7,500] \$12,575 per year.
- 12 (4) In a borough with a population in excess of 15,000,
- a maximum of [\$500] \$840 per year per 1,000 residents or
- fraction of 1,000, the population to be determined by the
- 15 latest official census figures.

- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
