## AN ACT

- Amending Title 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania
  Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions relating
  to inmate confinement, providing for family consideration in
  placement and visitation.

- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 61 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 <u>§ 5908. Family consideration in placement and visitation.</u>
- 10 (a) Placement. -- To the greatest extent possible, after
- 11 accounting for security and capacity factors, the department
- 12 shall ensure that incarcerated mothers of a minor dependent
- 13 shall be placed within 250 miles of their permanent address of
- 14 <u>record.</u>
- 15 (b) Visitation.--The department shall authorize visitation
- 16 by minor dependents, with the minimum following requirements:
- 17 (1) opportunities for dependent children under 18 years

1	of age to visit their mother at least two days per week;
2	(2) elimination of restrictions on the number of
3	dependent children under 18 years of age that may be
4	permitted visitation privileges; and
5	(3) authorization of contact visits for mothers with
6	low-security or minimum-security classifications.
7	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
