AN ACT

Amending the act of April 8, 1868 (P.L.73, No.37), entitled "An 1 act to authorize the recorder of deeds in the several 2 counties of this Commonwealth to record the discharges of all 3 honorably discharged officers and soldiers," further 4 5 providing for confidentiality of records. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of April 8, 1868 (P.L.73, 9 No.37), entitled "An act to authorize the recorder of deeds in the several counties of this Commonwealth to record the 10 discharges of all honorably discharged officers and soldiers," 11 is amended to read: 12 13 Section 2. Records of discharges, reports of separation and 14 similar forms recorded or received by the recorder of deeds for 15 recording under section 1 shall be confidential and no 16 disclosure thereof shall be made by the recorder of deeds except 17 as follows:

1 (1) To the person who is the subject of the record, report 2 or form; or to a member of his immediate family; or to his agent 3 or representative duly authorized in writing.

4 [(2) To a person making a request for a record, report or 5 form when the event that resulted in the record, report or form 6 occurred more than seventy-five years prior to the request.]

7 (3) When required by process of a court to be produced in8 any suit or proceeding therein pending.

9 (4) When required by the county director of veterans affairs 10 or any department or other agency of the State or United States 11 Government.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
