AN ACT

Amending the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), entitled

"An act providing for independent oversight and review of 2 regulations, creating an Independent Regulatory Review Commission, providing for its powers and duties and making repeals," providing for review of regulatory actions FURTHER <-- PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS AND FOR CLASSIFICATION OF 6 DOCUMENTS. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known <--10 as the Regulatory Review Act, is amended by adding a section to 11 12 read: 13 Section 11.1. Review of regulatory actions. 14 Upon request by a regulated entity, the commission shall determine whether the requirements of a regulatory 15 16 by an agency are excessive and whether the requirements regulatory action should be submitted for review 17 18 regulation under this act. (b) If the commission determines that the requirements 19

2	requirements should be submitted for review as a separate
3	regulation under this act, the commission shall have the
4	following duties:
5	(1) Require the agency to revise the requirements of the
6	regulatory action and submit the requirements for review as a
7	separate regulation under this act.
8	(2) Notify the agency of the requirements of the
9	regulatory action which the commission determines to be
10	excessive and provide recommendations to the agency on how to
11	improve the requirements.
12	(3) Notify the agency on why the requirements of the
13	regulatory action should be issued for review as a separate
14	regulation.
15	(4) Refrain from providing the agency with any
16	information relating to whether the commission would approve
17	a proposed regulation with the requirements of the regulatory
18	<u>action.</u>
19	(c) Upon receiving a request from a regulated entity to
20	review a regulatory action, the commission shall order the
21	agency to provide the commission with information pertaining to
22	the regulatory action no later than 45 days after the agency
23	receives the order. The information shall include all of the
24	<u>following:</u>
25	(1) The statutory authority for the regulatory action.
26	(2) The agency's explanation of the necessary functions
27	of the regulatory action, including whether the requirements
28	of the regulatory action should be submitted for review under
29	<u>a separate regulation.</u>
30	(3) The agency's explanation for utilizing the

Τ	requirements of the requiatory action, rather than submitting
2	the requirements of the regulatory action for review as a
3	separate regulation.
4	(4) Any costs, including indirect costs, associated with
5	the regulatory action to the Commonwealth.
6	(5) Any costs, including indirect costs, associated with
7	regulatory action to regulated entities.
8	(6) The estimated or average duration of time it takes
9	for a regulated entity to comply with the requirements of the
10	regulatory action.
11	(d) In order to comply with subsection (c), an agency may
12	request an additional 15 days to comply with the commission's
13	order to provide the commission with information pertaining to
14	the regulatory action.
15	(e) After the commission receives the information required
16	from the agency under subsection (c), the commission shall allow
17	regulated entities a 30-day period to submit comments to the
18	commission pertaining to whether the requirements of the
19	regulatory action should be submitted as a separate regulation.
20	No later than 30 days after the commission receives the comments
21	from the regulated entities or at the next meeting of the
22	commission, whichever is later, the commission shall review the
23	comments and the information received from the agency under
24	subsection (c) and make a determination on all of the following:
25	(1) Whether the requirements of the regulatory action
26	<u>are excessive.</u>
27	(2) Whether the requirements of the regulatory action
28	should be submitted for review under a separate regulation.
29	(f) Regulated entities shall not be required to comply with
30	the requirements of a regulatory action under review by the

- 1 commission under subsection (e). If the commission determines
- 2 that the requirements of a regulatory action should be submitted
- 3 <u>for review as a separate regulation, the regulated entities</u>
- 4 shall not be required to comply with the requirements unless the
- 5 requirements are included in a final form regulation approved
- 6 under this act.
- 7 (q) An agency may not issue similar requirements through a
- 8 regulatory action if the commission has determined that similar
- 9 requirements should be submitted for review as a separate
- 10 regulation.
- 11 (h) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 12 <u>shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless</u>
- 13 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 14 <u>"Excessive." A regulatory action that exceeds or is beyond</u>
- 15 the scope of an agency's approved regulatory authority by the
- 16 commission.
- 17 "Permit." An authorization issued by an agency that approves
- 18 the performance of an activity under the agency's jurisdiction.
- 19 The term includes an authorization permit and a plan approval or
- 20 registration under a general permit.
- 21 "Regulated entity." Any individual, person, organization or
- 22 corporation that engages in an activity in this Commonwealth
- 23 <u>that requires regulatory approval by an agency.</u>
- 24 "Regulatory action." Any permit or policy guideline issued
- 25 by an agency under this act.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 27 SECTION 1. SECTION 3 OF THE ACT OF JUNE 25, 1982 (P.L.633, <--
- 28 NO.181), KNOWN AS THE REGULATORY REVIEW ACT, IS AMENDED BY
- 29 ADDING A DEFINITION TO READ:
- 30 SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS.

- 1 THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS ACT SHALL
- 2 HAVE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE, THE
- 3 MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION:
- 4 * * *
- 5 "REGULATED ENTITY." ANY INDIVIDUAL, PERSON, ORGANIZATION OR
- 6 CORPORATION THAT ENGAGES IN AN ACTIVITY IN THIS COMMONWEALTH
- 7 THAT REQUIRES REGULATORY APPROVAL BY AN AGENCY.

- 9 SECTION 2. SECTION 7.1 OF THE ACT IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 10 SECTION 7.1. CLASSIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS.
- 11 IF THE COMMISSION [OR], A COMMITTEE OR A REGULATED ENTITY
- 12 FINDS THAT A PUBLISHED OR UNPUBLISHED DOCUMENT SHOULD BE
- 13 PROMULGATED AS A REGULATION, THE COMMISSION [OR], COMMITTEE OR
- 14 REGULATED ENTITY MAY PRESENT THE MATTER TO THE JOINT COMMITTEE
- 15 ON DOCUMENTS. THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON DOCUMENTS SHALL DETERMINE
- 16 WHETHER THE DOCUMENT SHOULD BE PROMULGATED AS A REGULATION AND
- 17 MAY ORDER AN AGENCY EITHER TO PROMULGATE THE DOCUMENT AS A
- 18 REGULATION WITHIN 180 DAYS OR TO DESIST FROM THE USE OF THE
- 19 DOCUMENT IN THE BUSINESS OF THE AGENCY.
- 20 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
