AN ACT

Amending the act of July 9, 1970 (P.L.484, No.164), entitled "An 1 act relating to indemnification agreements between 2 architects, engineers or surveyors and owners, contractors, 3 subcontractors or suppliers," further providing for title of act; and providing for indemnification agreements relative to 5 construction contracts. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The title of the act of July 9, 1970 (P.L.484, 10 No.164), entitled "An act relating to indemnification agreements between architects, engineers or surveyors and owners, 11 12 contractors, subcontractors or suppliers," is amended to read: 13 AN ACT Relating to indemnification agreements between architects, 14 15 engineers or surveyors and owners, contractors, 16 subcontractors or suppliers[.] and indemnification agreements 17 relative to construction contracts. 18 Section 2. The act is amended by adding sections to read: 19 Section 1.1. Any provision or term in any construction

- 1 contract in which an owner, contractor, subcontractor or
- 2 <u>supplier or the agents or employes of the owner, contractor,</u>
- 3 <u>subcontractor or supplier shall be indemnified or held harmless</u>
- 4 for damages, claims, losses or expenses arising out of bodily
- 5 <u>injury to persons or damage to property caused by or resulting</u>
- 6 from the negligence, in whole or in part, of the owner,
- 7 contractor, subcontractor, supplier or the agents or employes of
- 8 the owner, contractor, subcontractor or supplier, shall be void
- 9 as against public policy and unenforceable.
- 10 <u>Section 1.2. As used in this act, the term "construction</u>
- 11 contract" means a covenant, agreement or understanding in, or in
- 12 connection with any contract or agreement made and entered into
- 13 by an owner, contractor, subcontractor or supplier or the agents
- 14 or employes of the owner, contractor, subcontractor or supplier
- 15 relative to the construction, reconstruction, alteration,
- 16 repair, maintenance, servicing or security of a building,
- 17 <u>structure</u>, highway, railroad, appurtenance or appliance.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
