## AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and
18	prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation
19	of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of

Ζ⊥	determined," providing for emergency COVID-19 provisions.
22	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
23	hereby enacts as follows:
24	Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
25	as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding an
26	article to read:

2	EMERGENCY COVID-19 PROVISIONS
3	Section 101-A. Extension of waiver provisions.
4	(a) WaiverThe Secretary of Community and Economic
5	Development shall immediately issue a waiver to the Governor's
6	20200319 TWW COVID 19 Business Closure Order to all licensed
7	racing entities to hold horse race meetings if all of the
8	following apply:
9	(1) The licensed racing entities can, at a racetrack or
10	racetrack enclosure, provide for the adherence to the social
11	distancing practices and other mitigation measures defined by
12	the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to protect
13	workers and to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
14	(2) The State Horse Racing Commission authorizes the
15	activities necessary to regulate horse race meetings.
16	(3) The Pennsylvania Race Horse Testing Program under 3
17	<u>Pa.C.S. § 9372 (relating to establishment of Pennsylvania</u>
18	Race Horse Testing Program) is operational at the time the
19	horse race meetings are conducted.
20	(b) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
21	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
22	subsection:
23	<u>"Horse race meeting." As defined in 3 Pa.C.S. § 9301</u>
24	(relating to definitions).
25	"Licensed racing entity." As defined in 3 Pa.C.S. § 9301.
26	<u>"Racetrack." As defined in 3 Pa.C.S. § 9301.</u>
27	<u>"Racetrack enclosure." As defined in 3 Pa.C.S. § 9301.</u>
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
