AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 55864, on State
2 Route 4016, also known as Millfair Road, over the CSX
3 Railroad in Fairview Township, Erie County, as the John A.
4 Pulice Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. John A. Pulice Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) John A. Pulice served in the United States Navy
11 during the Korean War where he was decorated with various
12 medals of recognition and rose to the rank of Chief Petty
13 Officer. After his honorable discharge, he remained active in
14 the United States Naval Reserve.

15 (2) He subsequently worked as the Regional Director of
16 the Pennsylvania Lottery for the Pennsylvania Department of
17 Revenue.

18 (3) From 1980 to 1998, he was an elected member of the

1 Millcreek Township School Board, during which time he served
2 as president, vice president and chairman of several key
3 committees.

4 (4) In 2004, he was appointed by the Governor to the
5 Edinboro University Council of Trustees, and served as
6 Secretary since 2011.

7 (5) He also served as a commissioner of the Millcreek
8 Township Planning and Zoning Commission since 2000.

9 (6) A dedicated and longstanding public servant, John A.
10 Pulice was affectionately known to many in the community as
11 the "Mayor of Millcreek."

12 (7) On October 6, 2020, John A. Pulice passed away at
13 the age of 87.

14 (b) Designation.--The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
15 55864, on State Route 4016, also known as Millfair Road, over
16 the CSX Railroad in Fairview Township, Erie County, is
17 designated as the John A. Pulice Memorial Bridge.

18 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
19 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
20 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

21 Section 2. Effective date.

22 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
