- Designating the month of March 2019 as "Irish-American Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.

- 5 glorious apostle of Ireland, Saint Patrick; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The theme of the 2019 St. Patrick's Day Parade in
- 7 Philadelphia is "Saint Patrick, Unite Us!"; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Fleeing political, religious and racial persecution
- 9 in Ireland, Irish immigrants arrived on our shores penniless and
- 10 unwanted, yet filled with hope that the United States held a
- 11 future in which Irish immigrants and their families would enjoy
- 12 the bountiful fruits of a nation founded upon the principles of
- 13 liberty and justice for all; and

- 2 Americans have been at the forefront of political, economic,
- 3 religious, social and artistic fields; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Irish-American contributions to this Commonwealth
