A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of May 2019 as "Dementia Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, A growing number of Pennsylvanians are facing the
- 4 challenge of living with various forms of dementia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's families who have loved ones with
- 6 dementia are to be recognized for the courage, dedication and
- 7 sacrifices they make in providing care; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Many residents throughout the Commonwealth are
- 9 professional caregivers who provide an important and difficult
- 10 service for those they assist and the caregivers should be
- 11 recognized for their hard work; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has a growing older population that
- 13 is more likely to need assistance from neighbors, good
- 14 samaritans and first responders due to dementia and who are at
- 15 risk for elopement; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The health and safety of Pennsylvanians living with
- 17 dementia is of the utmost importance; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The Dementia Society of America has created
- 2 Operation Keepsafe which provides basic education and low or no
- 3 cost kits containing an identification bracelet, wallet card,
- 4 identification stickers, instructions and helpful information;
- 5 therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 7 month of May 2019 as "Dementia Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania;
- 8 and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge local
- 10 communities to adopt the Operation Keepsafe program to help keep
- 11 vulnerable Pennsylvanians safe and assist the families and
- 12 caregivers who aid those with dementia.
