## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the month of October 2019 as "National Breast Cancer Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania and October 18, 2019, as
- "National Mammography Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, "National Breast Cancer Awareness Month" was founded
- 5 in 1985 and has since evolved into a collaboration of national
- 6 public service organizations, professional medical associations
- 7 and government agencies working together to promote breast
- 8 cancer awareness, share information about the disease and
- 9 provide greater access to services; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Since its inception more than 30 years ago, the
- 11 "National Breast Cancer Awareness Month" effort has stood at the
- 12 forefront of promoting awareness of breast cancer issues; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Much work remains to educate both women and men
- 14 about breast health in order for them to take charge of their
- 15 health through practicing routine breast self-exams to identify

- 1 changes, scheduling regular doctor visits and mammograms as
- 2 recommended, adhering to prescribed treatment and knowing the
- 3 facts about recurrence; and
- 4 WHEREAS, An important part of raising awareness involves the
- 5 importance of screening and detecting cancer in its early stages
- 6 so that treatment can occur, increasing survival rates and
- 7 healing and decreasing suffering; and
- 8 WHEREAS, A mammogram serves as a screening test for breast
- 9 cancer that can detect cancer early; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Screening for breast cancer for women 40 years of
- 11 age or older through mammograms helps ensure early detection of
- 12 breast cancer; and
- 13 WHEREAS, "National Mammography Day" has existed since 1993
- 14 when President Bill Clinton first proclaimed the third Friday of
- 15 October as "National Mammography Day" to encourage women,
- 16 particularly those in high-risk groups, to make a mammography
- 17 appointment during the month of October; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Raising breast cancer awareness remains an important
- 19 issue; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that in the
- 21 United States during 2019, 268,600 new cases of invasive breast
- 22 cancer will be diagnosed in women, 41,760 women will die from
- 23 breast cancer, 2,670 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be
- 24 diagnosed in men and 500 men will die from breast cancer;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 27 month of October 2019 as "National Breast Cancer Awareness
- 28 Month" in Pennsylvania and October 18, 2019, as "National
- 29 Mammography Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 30 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all women

- 1 and men in this Commonwealth to have discussions with their
- 2 doctors about breast cancer, particularly about the value of
- 3 getting screened for breast cancer, especially if possible signs
- 4 of breast cancer are detected; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage women
- 6 in this Commonwealth 40 years of age or older to undergo annual
- 7 mammograms and urge women 55 years of age or older to recognize
- 8 the benefit of undergoing mammograms every two years; and be it
- 9 further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge residents to
- 11 take action during the month of October and throughout the year
- 12 to remain informed about the incidence of breast cancer and how
- 13 residents of this Commonwealth can protect themselves from the
- 14 disease and take proper action if breast cancer develops.
