A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2019 as "Self-Care Awareness Month" in this Commonwealth.
- 3 WHEREAS, The observance of "Self-Care Awareness Month" in
- 4 September reminds residents to pay attention to their health;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, Self-care requires an individual to recognize when
- 7 it is appropriate to self-treat conditions and when to seek
- 8 professional assistance from a health care practitioner; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Self-care supports good health and helps develop
- 10 lifelong healthy lifestyle choices, including good hygiene
- 11 practices, nutritious diet, regular exercise, prevention of
- 12 infection and illness, avoiding unhealthy choices and monitoring
- 13 for signs and symptoms of changes in health; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Self-care is a cornerstone of helping to reduce the
- 15 overall cost of health care in this Commonwealth and the
- 16 country; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Consumers have access to a wide range of over-the-

- 1 counter medications which were originally sold only by
- 2 prescription; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The United States Food and Drug Administration deems
- 4 over-the-counter medicine safe and effective for the self-care
- 5 treatment of minor acute and chronic health conditions and
- 6 symptoms such as pain, the common cold and allergies, which
- 7 impact large segments of the population; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Every dollar spent on over-the-counter medicines
- 9 saves more than \$7 for the health care system, resulting in more
- 10 than \$146 billion in annual savings; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Over-the-counter medical devices used for the
- 12 purposes of treatment and testing generate additional annual
- 13 savings of \$8 billion to the health care system; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Over-the-counter medicines help to ease the burden
- 15 on health care practitioners, eliminating unnecessary medical
- 16 examinations which could be avoided with appropriate self-care;
- 17 and
- 18 WHEREAS, A reduction in unnecessary visits to health care
- 19 practitioners allows doctors and nurses to focus more on
- 20 patients who need their special expertise; therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 22 month of September 2019 as "Self-Care Awareness Month" in this
- 23 Commonwealth; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 25 importance of improving awareness of self-care and the value it
- 26 represents to the residents of this Commonwealth; and be it
- 27 further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives acknowledge that
- 29 over-the-counter medicines and devices can greatly reduce costs
- 30 to the public health system; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage the
- 2 residents of this Commonwealth to take advantage of the
- 3 availability of self-care to improve personal and public health,
- 4 save personal and public treasury and strengthen the
- 5 sustainability of the health care system in this Commonwealth.
