| 16     | WHEREAS, Individuals diagnosed with PBD-ZSD and related $\blacktriangleleft$             |

single enzyme deficiencies inherit the disease in an autosomal
 recessive inheritance pattern; and

3 WHEREAS, There are very few treatments and still no cure for
4 PBD-ZSD and related single enzyme deficiencies, which impact an 
5 estimated 1 in 50,000 live births annually; and

6 WHEREAS, All patients seeking care for PBD-ZSD and related
7 single enzyme deficiencies suffer from a variety of health
8 issues, causing a severe strain on resources and on the delivery
9 of health care in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Individuals diagnosed with PBD-ZSD and related single enzyme deficiencies are instilled with fear of an unknown future with a life-threatening genetic disease and apprehension over possible discrimination, including the risk of losing their health and life insurance, their jobs and their chances of promotion; and

16 WHEREAS, Friends, loved ones, spouses and caregivers of 17 patients seeking care for PBD-ZSD and related single enzyme 18 deficiencies must shoulder the physical, emotional and financial 19 burdens of the disease; and

20 WHEREAS, Individuals who have chronic, life-threatening diseases like PBD-ZSD and related single enzyme deficiencies and ◀ 21 their caregivers have a predisposition to depression because of 22 23 their anxiety over pain, suffering and premature death; and 24 WHEREAS, Peroxisomal disorder awareness and education are 25 important to raise public awareness and understanding of PBD-ZSD < 26 and related single enzyme deficiencies; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate October 27 28 5, 2019, as "Peroxisomal Disorder Awareness Day" in 29 Pennsylvania.

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
