A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of May 3 through 10, 2020, as "National
2 Music Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Music is the universal language of the world,
4 inspiring millions of people around the globe in a multitude of
5 positive ways; and

6 WHEREAS, Sponsored annually by the National Federation of
7 Music Clubs, "National Music Week" serves to enhance our
8 understanding and appreciation of the value of music in the
9 home, the community, the nation and the world; and

10 WHEREAS, The week of May 3 through 10 marks the 95th annual
11 observance of "National Music Week"; and

12 WHEREAS, This year's theme is "Music...A Magic Carpet"; and

13 WHEREAS, Music can bring joy to each person's life,
14 refreshing and soothing our minds and giving lofty inspiration
15 to our souls; and

16 WHEREAS, Listening to music is one of the most popular forms

1 of entertainment and is enjoyed by individuals and groups from
2 virtually all walks of life; and

3 WHEREAS, Music is an integral part of the American cultural
4 experience and ubiquitous in our everyday lives; and

5 WHEREAS, Music stimulates the imagination, is often thought
6 provoking, can generate a wide range of emotions and may evoke
7 fond memories; and

8 WHEREAS, The study of music enhances learning, and composing
9 and performing music provides a rich, rewarding experience for
10 people of all ages; and

11 WHEREAS, Music distinguishes generations of people from one
12 another and, at the same time, can uniquely establish a common
13 bond between different generations; and

14 WHEREAS, Music is an important form of art that can reflect
15 the history and culture of a region, state or country; and

16 WHEREAS, Music is a key element of most artistic
17 performances, including dance, theater and film; and

18 WHEREAS, Music can be spiritual in nature, and virtually all
19 religions utilize music in their expression of spiritual life;

21 WHEREAS, Music has vast potential to inspire peace, harmony
22 and understanding among disparate people and penetrate and tear
23 down walls of intolerance, hatred and injustice around the
24 world; and

25 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a rich history and tradition
26 of musical involvement and enjoyment in the lives of its
27 residents; therefore be it

28 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
29 week of May 3 through 10, 2020, as "National Music Week" in
30 Pennsylvania; and be it further
