## AN ACT

| 15                                   | Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known  |
| 16                                   | as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding an  |

| 19                                   | CONDUCT OF EARLY VOTING   |
| 20                                   | IN PRIMARIES AND ELECTIONS  |
| 21                                   | Section 1201-A. Early voting period.  |
| 22                                   | A county board shall provide for early voting which shall   |

- 1 begin 15 days prior to the dates of primaries and elections
- 2 established under Article VI and end 14 days after the starting
- 3 <u>date.</u>
- 4 <u>Section 1202-A. Early voting sites.</u>
- 5 <u>A county board shall designate early voting sites where</u>
- 6 <u>electors may cast ballots during the early voting period</u>
- 7 established under section 1201-A. These sites shall include the
- 8 main office of the county board and any other sites designated
- 9 by the county board. The county board shall make available at
- 10 these sites the same equipment used on election day under
- 11 Article XI. The early voting sites shall be geographically
- 12 located to provide electors in the election district an equal
- 13 opportunity to cast a ballot.
- 14 Section 1203-A. Days and times for opening and closing polls at
- 15 <u>early voting sites.</u>
- A county board shall designate the days and times that early
- 17 voting sites will be open. All early voting sites throughout the
- 18 county shall:
- 19 (1) have uniform days and times of operation;
- 20 (2) be open eight hours each weekday;
- 21 (3) be open a minimum of an aggregate eight hours each
- 22 weekend; and
- 23 (4) not open prior to 7 a.m. Eastern Standard Time or
- 24 close before 7 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.
- 25 Section 1204-A. Voting check list.
- A county board shall maintain a voting check list as provided
- 27 for in section 1212 in order to ensure that electors are
- 28 prohibited from casting additional ballots at either an early
- 29 voting site or on election day in the elector's precinct.
- 30 Section 1205-A. Disposition of returns.

- 1 A county board shall track votes by precinct but may not\_
- 2 tabulate votes prior to the close of the polls on election day.
- 3 Section 1206-A. Notice of early voting.
- 4 A county board shall, no earlier than 15 days nor later than
- 5 <u>9 days before each November election, give notice of early</u>
- 6 voting by newspaper publication in the county in accordance with
- 7 the provisions of section 106. The notice shall be published
- 8 twice in counties of the first class and once in all other
- 9 counties. A county board shall also post the notice on the
- 10 county board's publicly accessible Internet website.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
