A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of September 17 through 23, 2020, as
2 "Constitution Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The Constitution of the United States adopted the
4 principles upon which our Republic was established; and

5 WHEREAS, September 17, 2020, marks the 233rd anniversary of
6 the framing of the Constitution of the United States by the
7 Constitutional Convention; and

8 WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper to accord official
9 recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable
10 anniversary and the patriotic celebrations which commemorate it;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Each year, the President of the United States issues
13 a proclamation that designates September 17 through 23 as
14 "Constitution Week"; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of September 17
16 through 23, 2020, as "Constitution Week" in Pennsylvania and
17 urge all Pennsylvanians to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of

1 the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the
2 freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our
3 liberties.
