## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in public indecency, further providing 2 for the offense of prostitution and related offenses. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 5902(f) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 5902. Prostitution and related offenses. 9 \* \* \* 10 (e.3) Amnesty for sex workers, sexually exploited children 11 12 and victims of human trafficking reporting a crime of 13 violence. -- The following shall apply: (1) A sex worker, sexually exploited child or victim of 14 15 human trafficking who reports to a peace officer or law 16 enforcement agency that the sex worker, sexually exploited child or victim of human trafficking is a victim of or a 17

witness to a crime of violence may not be arrested for the

- 2 reporting the crime of violence.
- 3 (2) A law enforcement agency may not publicly release
- 4 the name of an individual who is alleged to be a sex worker,
- 5 <u>sexually exploited child or victim of human trafficking who</u>
- 6 reports being a victim of or witness to a crime of violence
- 7 <u>under paragraph (1) without the written permission of the</u>
- 8 <u>individual</u>.
- 9 (3) As used in this section, the following words and
- 10 phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 11 paragraph unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Crime of violence." As defined in section 5702
- 13 <u>(relating to definitions).</u>
- "Peace officer." As defined in section 501 (relating to
- definitions).
- "Sexually exploited child." As defined in section 3001
- 17 (relating to definitions).
- 18 "Victim of human trafficking." As defined in section
- 19 3001.
- 20 (f) Definitions.--As used in this section the following
- 21 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 22 subsection:
- "House of prostitution." Any place where prostitution or
- 24 promotion of prostitution is regularly carried on by one person
- 25 under the control, management or supervision of another.
- 26 "Inmate." A person who engages in prostitution in or through
- 27 the agency of a house of prostitution.
- 28 "Minor." An individual under 18 years of age.
- 29 "Public place." Any place to which the public or any
- 30 substantial group thereof has access.

- 1 <u>"Sex worker." An individual 18 years of age or older who</u>
- 2 <u>negotiates and performs sexual services for remuneration.</u>
- 3 "Sexual activity." Includes homosexual and other deviate
- 4 sexual relations.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
