AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4
- laws relating thereto," in professional employees, providing 5
- for National Guard and Reserve parent student support. 6
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 8
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1184. National Guard and Reserve Parent Student
- 13 Support. -- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- 14 student who is a child of a member of the National Guard and
- 15 Reserve shall be afforded the same rights as a student of an
- 16 active duty military family under the act of February 2, 2012
- (P.L.42, No.6), known as the Interstate Compact on Educational 17
- Opportunity for Military Children Act, if a parent is required 18

- 1 to move to perform the parent's responsibilities in the service
- 2 of the National Guard or Reserve resulting in the student having
- 3 to transfer from a public school in one state to a public school
- 4 <u>in another state.</u>
- 5 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 6 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 7 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 8 "Public school." The term shall have the same meaning as the
- 9 term "public school entity" as defined in section 1183.
- 10 "Student." The child of a member of the National Guard or
- 11 Reserve for whom the public school receives public funding and
- 12 who is formally enrolled in kindergarten through twelfth grade.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
