## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of June 2022 as "Lithuanian Partnership Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, In June 2022, the Commonwealth is marking the 29th
- 4 anniversary of an excellent partnership between the Pennsylvania
- 5 National Guard and Lithuanian Armed Forces; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania National Guard and Lithuanian Armed
- 7 Forces affiliation is one of 22 European partnerships comprising
- 8 the United States European Command State Partnership Program;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The partnership is one of 65 worldwide
- 11 collaborations that constitute the National Guard State
- 12 Partnership Program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The partnership was established April 27, 1993, and
- 14 Pennsylvania's brave men and women continue to serve in
- 15 Lithuania; and
- 16 WHEREAS, There is a significant Baltic population in
- 17 Pennsylvania, including individuals of Estonian, Latvian and
- 18 Lithuanian descent; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The United States and Lithuania are North Atlantic
- 2 Treaty Organization allies; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The partnership was borne out of the fall of the
- 4 Soviet Union in 1991; and
- 5 WHEREAS, On June 14, a "Day of Mourning and Hope" was
- 6 observed in Lithuania, marking the deportation of 30,000
- 7 Lithuanians by the Soviet Union to Siberia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The deportations were part of 35 mass expulsions
- 9 carried out in 1941, and from 1945 through 1952; and
- 10 WHEREAS, About 300,000 people were deported in total, with
- 11 70% representing women and children; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Due to cold and difficult conditions, as well as
- 13 starvation, plagues and psychological abuse, many Lithuanians
- 14 died during the deportation; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The atrocities led to a decade-long armed resistance
- 16 against the Soviet Union in the Baltics and, ultimately, the
- 17 vindication of our Lithuanian friends; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth values its friendship, partnership
- 19 and bond with Lithuania; and
- 20 WHEREAS, As Pennsylvanians, we stand in solidarity with our
- 21 friends and allies in Estonia, Latvia and especially Lithuania
- 22 due to its deep and long relationship with the Commonwealth;
- 23 therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the month of June 2022 as
- 25 "Lithuanian Partnership Month" in Pennsylvania.
