AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, 5 providing for supplemental mathematics program for grades kindergarten through five. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: 13 Section 1555. Supplemental Mathematics Program for Grades Kindergarten Through Five. -- (a) Beginning with the 2023-2024 14 school year, the department shall select a mathematics program 15 16 for kindergarten through fifth grade learners that meets the 17 following qualifications:

(1) Demonstrates experience in teaching mathematics.

(2) Functions as a flexible supplemental resource.

20 (3) Is designed to:

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- 1 (i) Strengthen fact fluency, automaticity, computational
- 2 thinking and other critical skills in mathematics.
- 3 (ii) Include in-class demonstration, modeling and coaching
- 4 <u>support to assist all students in meeting grade-level</u>
- 5 <u>mathematics in accordance with the State academic standards</u>
- 6 approved by the State Board of Education.
- 7 (b) The department shall upload the mathematics program on
- 8 <u>its publicly accessible Internet website for a school entity,</u>
- 9 <u>nonpublic school and home education supervisor to voluntarily</u>
- 10 download and administer the mathematics program to students. The
- 11 <u>department may not charge a fee for the mathematics program.</u>
- 12 <u>(c) The department shall establish criteria by which a</u>
- 13 <u>school can measure mathematics outcomes.</u>
- 14 (d) The department shall report to the General Assembly each
- 15 July 1 of the next year the number of school entities, nonpublic
- 16 schools and home education supervisors that voluntarily
- 17 downloaded the mathematics program.
- 18 (e) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 19 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 20 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 21 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 22 Commonwealth.
- 23 "Mathematics program." The mathematics program described in
- 24 subsection (a).
- 25 "Nonpublic school." As defined in section 922.1-A(b).
- 26 "School entity." A school district, intermediate unit,
- 27 <u>charter school, cyber charter school or regional charter school.</u>
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
