SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in transfers of credits between institutions of higher education, further providing for definitions, for duties of public institutions of higher education and for transfer and articulation oversight committee. (Representatives ROEBUCK, BISHOP, V. BROWN and others) – Education, March 2, 2015 6

This bill amends the Public School Code to provide for uniform standards for awarding college credit for prior learning at public institutions of higher education.



This bill repeals a requirement that the General Assembly be furnished with a print copy of annual report required under the Flood Insurance Education and Information Act of 1996.
