SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILLS

HOUSE

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, in organization of 2069 independent administrative boards and commissions, further providing for Agricultural Lands Condemnation Approval Board. (Representatives CAUSER, PASHINSKI, CUTLER and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

VOTE



This bill provides for alternate farmer appointments to the Agricultural Lands Condemnation Approval Board.

HOUSE

1550

An Act amending the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128, No.43), known as the Agricultural Area Security Law, further providing 2070 for purchase of agricultural conservation easements. (Representatives KLUNK, BERNSTINE, GODSHALL and others) - Rules, June 28,

VOTE



This bill amends the Agricultural Area Security Law to provide for restrictions, limitations and subdivision on preserved farmland.

SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILLS

HOUSE 1094 1356

An Act amending the act of November 29, 2006 (P.L.1463, No.163), known as the Credit Reporting Agency Act, further providing for definitions and for security freeze; and providing for protected persons security freeze. (Representatives BARRAR, V. BROWN, D. COSTA and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

VOTE



This bill provides for definitions and for security freeze.

HOUSE 1213 1486

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in consolidated county assessment, further providing for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts and providing for standards of redress in appeals. (Representatives KAMPF, GODSHALL, McGINNIS and others) - Commerce, June 27, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER AFFAIRS BILL

179

An Act amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in contract carrier by motor vehicle and broker, further providing for declaration of policy and definitions; and, in violations and penalties, further providing for unauthorized operation by carriers and brokers. (Representatives DAY, KNOWLES, D. COSTA and others) – Consumer Affairs. June 27, 2017

OVER

This bill amends Title 66 to increase penalties for unlicensed household goods movers operating in the Commonwealth.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

332

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives GROVE, BLOOM, NELSON and others) – Finance, June 22, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for classes of income.

SECOND CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILLS

HOUSE 1286

An Act amending the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known as the Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Act, in medical professional liability, providing for punitive damages study. (Representatives MENTZER, ZIMMERMAN, HICKERNELL and others) – Insurance, June 5, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for punitive damages study.

HOUSE 1576 2064

An Act amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of 1921, providing for limited lines travel insurance. (Representatives PICKETT AND DeLUCA) - Rules, June 21, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for limited lines travel insurance.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE

1699 a

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives CUTLER, DEAN, DRISCOLL and others) – Judiciary, June 27, 2017

OVER

This bill is a summary of proposed legislation and is prepared only as general information for use by the Republican Members and staff of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

HOUSE

1497

An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in protection from abuse, further providing for relief. (Representatives MARSICO, READSHAW, KNOWLES and others) – Judiciary, June 22, 2017

OVER

This bill amends the Protection From Abuse Act to add another type of relief for the plaintiff by allowing the court to order the defendant to refrain from abusing the plaintiff's cat or dog.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 1469 2016

An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in adoption and enforcement by municipalities, further providing for administration and enforcement. (Representatives HEFFLEY, McGINNIS, MILLARD and others) - Rules, June 21, 2017

VOTE



This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to require that building permit applications in municipalities using one or more third party agency to enforce the Uniform Construction Code, contain a written notice on where complaints can be directed about the performance of such agencies.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LIQUOR CONTROL BILL

HOUSE 1497 2007

An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in preliminary provisions, further defining "alcoholic cider" and "public venue"; and, in licenses and regulations for liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages, further providing for wine and spirits auction permits. (Representatives JOZWIAK, TALLMAN, ROTHMAN and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

VOTE



This bill amends the Liquor Code to align PA's definition of alcoholic cider with federal definition.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 641 1712

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assessments of persons and property, providing for senior property tax freeze. (Representatives GROVE, SCHWEYER, JAMES and others) – Local Government, June 7, 2017

OVER

This bill establishes an Optional Senior Property Tax Freeze program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 1364 2017

An Act amending the act of October 27, 1979 (P.L.241, No.78), entitled "An act authorizing political subdivisions, municipality authorities and transportation authorities to enter into contracts for the purchase of goods and the sale of real and personal property where no bids are received," further providing for title of the act; adding a short title; and providing for contracts for services. (Representatives JAMES, HARPER, KAMPF and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

VOTE



This bill allows municipalities to enter into certain contracts when bids are not received after advertising twice.

SECOND CONSIDERATION PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE BILLS

HOUSE 1001 2093

An Act regulating home inspectors; establishing the Home Inspection Licensing Board; providing for licensure and practice, for disciplinary action, for remedies and for penalties; making an appropriation; and repealing provisions relating to home inspections. (Representatives HELM, KORTZ, BIZZARRO and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

OVER

This bill creates a freestanding act known as the Home Inspector Licensing Act to establish the Home Inspector Licensing Board within the Department of Labor and Industry.

HOUSE 1452

An Act amending the act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), referred to as the Barbers' License Law, further providing for definitions. (Representatives STURLA, ROZZI, RABB and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

VOTE

This bill amends the Barbers' License Law to allow barbers to practice outside of a licensed barber shop provided they accept no compensation for that work.



SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1175

An Act amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further providing for registration, for reporting, for prohibited activities, for penalties and for registration fees, fund established, system and regulations. (Representatives CUTLER, NEUMAN, MATZIE and others) – State Government, June 26, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for registration, for reporting, for prohibited activities, for penalties and for registration fees, fund established, system and regulations.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TOURISM AND RECREATIONAL DEV. BILL

HOUSE **544**

An Act amending the act of February 2, 1966 (1965 P.L.1860, No.586), entitled "An act encouraging landowners to make land and water areas available to the public for recreational purposes by limiting liability in connection therewith, and repealing certain acts," further providing for liability for landowners to recreational users; and providing for attorney fees and court costs. (Representatives MOUL, GREINER, PICKETT and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017

VOTE



This bill provides for liability for landowners to recreational users.

SECOND CONSIDERATION VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL

SENATE 137

An Act amending Titles 51 (Military Affairs) and 74 (Transportation) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military Affairs, providing for Civil Air Patrol; and, in authority of Department of Transportation, further providing for authority of department. (Senators McGARRIGLE, VULAKOVICH, GREENLEAF and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, June 28, 2017

VOTE



This bill codifies oversight of the PA Civil Air Patrol under DMVA.

THIRD CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

SENATE 365

An Act amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, in corporate powers, further providing for personal property. (Senators GORDNER, VULAKOVICH, COSTA and others) – Appropriations, June 22, 2017 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill provides for personal property.

A Resolution requesting the Congress of the United States to urge the Food and Drug Administration to reverse its directive allowing OxyContin to be prescribed to children 11 to 16 years of age. (Representatives BURNS, MURT, DiGIROLAMO and others) - Human Services, June 22, 2017
