9 Regulation of greenhouse gas emissions.

10 (a) General rule.--As a matter of Pennsylvania law,  
11 statutory and constitutional authority currently exists that  
12 authorizes a State agency to regulate or impose a tax on carbon  
13 dioxide emissions. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the  
14 General Assembly to work together with the Department of  
15 Environmental Protection, the Environmental Quality Board, the  
16 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and other important  
17 stakeholders, to regulate or impose a tax on carbon dioxide  
18 emissions.

19 (b) Authority.--The General Assembly recognizes that  
20 statute, including the act of January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119,  
21 No.787), known as the Air Pollution Control Act, the act of  
22 February 17, 1972 (P.L.64, No.20), known as the Uniform  
23 Interstate Air Pollution Agreements Act, the act of July 9, 2008  
24 (P.L.935, No.70), known as the Pennsylvania Climate Change Act  
25 or the Pennsylvania Constitution, authorizes the Governor, the  
26 Environmental Quality Board, the Department of Environmental  
27 Protection or any other agency or official to adopt regulations,  
28 implement a policy or take any other action to authorize the  
29 Commonwealth to join or participate in a State or regional  
30 greenhouse gas cap-and-trade program or establish a greenhouse  
31 gas cap-and-trade program.
