Regulation of greenhouse gas emissions.
(a) General rule.--As a matter of Pennsylvania law, statutory and constitutional authority currently exists that authorizes a State agency to regulate or impose a tax on carbon dioxide emissions. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the General Assembly to work together with the Department of Environmental Protection, the Environmental Quality Board, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and other important stakeholders, to regulate or impose a tax on carbon dioxide emissions.
(b) Authority.--The General Assembly recognizes that statute, including the act of January 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119, No.787), known as the Air Pollution Control Act, the act of February 17, 1972 (P.L.64, No.20), known as the Uniform Interstate Air Pollution Agreements Act, the act of July 9, 2008 (P.L.935, No.70), known as the Pennsylvania Climate Change Act or the Pennsylvania Constitution, authorizes the Governor, the Environmental Quality Board, the Department of Environmental Protection or any other agency or official to adopt regulations, implement a policy or take any other action to authorize the Commonwealth to join or participate in a State or regional greenhouse gas cap-and-trade program or establish a greenhouse gas cap-and-trade program.
