5 "Blow-dry styling" means the practice of shampooing,
6 conditioning, drying, arranging, curling, straightening or
7 styling hair using only mechanical devices or topical agents,
8 such as hairsprays, balms, oils or serums. The term:

9 (1) Includes the use and styling of hair extensions, hair
10 pieces or wigs and excludes cutting hair or the application of
11 dyes, bleach, reactive chemicals, keratin treatments or other
12 preparations to color or alter the structure of hair.

13 (2) Is distinct from the practice of cosmetology.

22 (1) To practice or teach cosmetology for compensation, or to
23 use or maintain any place for the practice of cosmetology for
24 compensation, or to use or maintain any place for the teaching
25 of cosmetology.

26 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 18 and 19

27 (b) An individual engaged solely in the practice of blow-dry
28 styling is exempt from this act.

29 (c) A facility where an individual provides a service under
30 subsection (b) and no other service requiring a license under

1 this act is exempt from cosmetology and esthetics salon license
2 requirements.
3 (d) An individual who is exempt from this act under
4 subsection (b) shall be permitted to provide a service under
5 subsection (b) and no other service requiring a license under
6 this act in a licensed cosmetology salon or licensed esthetics
7 salon.
