- "Purchasing agency." A Commonwealth agency authorized by law to enter into contracts for itself or as the agent of another Commonwealth agency.
- "Veteran." An individual who performed active service in the armed forces of the United States, including the reserve components and the National Guard, who was discharged from the active service under honorable conditions and who is domiciled in this Commonwealth.
- "Veteran-owned business." A business not less than 51% of which is owned by one or more veterans, or in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more veterans, and the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more veterans.
