

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 246

1 Amend Title, page 1, line 6, by inserting after "AREAS;"

18 Section 5. Posting of notice.

19 The proprietor of an adult-only establishment who permits  
20 smoking on the premises shall post a notice on the exterior of  
21 each entrance to the establishment identifying it as an  
22 establishment in which smoking is permitted and persons under 18  
23 years of age are not permitted without parental or adult  
24 supervision. The notice shall be of sufficient size as to be  
25 readable from a distance of 15 feet from the entrance of the  
26 establishment.

1 Section 7. Eligibility for unemployment compensation.  
2 An employee of an adult-only establishment that permits  
3 smoking on premises may leave employment within 60 days of the  
4 proprietor posting the notice required under section 5 and such  
5 action shall be deemed as leaving employment with cause of a  
6 necessitous and compelling nature under the act of December 5,  
7 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the  
8 Unemployment Compensation Law.
