1 Amend Bill, page 179, lines 22 through 30; page 180, lines 1
2 through 12, by striking out all of said lines on said pages and
3 inserting

4 (c) Notice of availability of assistance.--

5 (1) Each slot machine licensee shall obtain a toll-free
6 telephone number to be used to provide persons with
7 information on assistance for compulsive or problem gambling.
8 Each licensee shall conspicuously post signs similar to the
9 following statement:

10 If you or someone you know has a gambling problem, help
11 is available. Call (Toll-free telephone number).

12 The signs must be posted within 50 feet of each entrance
13 and exit [and], within 50 feet of each automated teller
14 machine location and a minimum of 20 signs must be posted
15 within the licensed facility.

16 (2) Each racetrack where slot machines are operated
17 shall print a statement on daily racing programs provided to
18 the general public that is similar to the following:

19 If you or someone you know has a gambling problem, help
20 is available. Call (Toll-free telephone number).

21 (3) A licensed facility which fails to post or print the
22 warning sign in accordance with paragraph (1) or (2) shall be
23 assessed a fine of \$1,000 a day for each day the sign is not
24 posted or printed as provided in this subsection.
