  - State system land. -- The department may not enter into a contract or lease in the name of the Commonwealth under this act unless it contains a provision that a lessee or its assignees may not request a waiver or a variance from the Department of Environmental Protection regarding a location restriction provided in the law of this Commonwealth without explicit written consent of the department, the system and the specific system school. The Department of Environmental Protection shall publish notice in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of the application for a waiver or variance under this subsection.
- (b) Certain land uses. -- The department may not enter into a 20 contract or lease in the name of the Commonwealth under this act unless it contains a provision that a lessee or its assignees may not request a waiver or a variance from the Department of Environmental Protection regarding a location restriction provided in the law of this Commonwealth for a building that is used as a residence, dormitory, student center, student health center, hospital, athletic facility, classroom, laboratory, auditorium, cafeteria, chapel or day care center.
- (c) Certain water uses. -- The department may not enter into a contract or lease in the name of the Commonwealth under this act unless it contains a provision that a lessee or its assignees may not request a waiver or a variance from the Department of Environmental Protection from a location restriction provided in the law of this Commonwealth regarding an existing water well, surface water intake, reservoir or other water supply extraction 35 point used by a water purveyor or solid blue lined stream,
