16 description of each position eliminated.

17 (5) The academic subjects, courses or electives and
18 nonacademic activities that will be affected by the suspension.

19 (6) A description of other cost-saving actions undertaken by
20 the school district.

21 (7) The measures the school district will undertake to
22 minimize the impact on student achievement, if any, caused by a
23 suspension of professional employees assigned to provide
24 instruction directly to students.
