1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 16, by inserting after "EMPLOYERS,"

2 for ineligibility of incarcerated employee,

3 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 29 and 30

4 Section 1.1. Section 402.6 of the act, amended December 9,  
5 2002 (P.L.1330, No.156), is amended to read:

6 Section 402.6. Ineligibility of Incarcerated Employee.--(a)  
7 An employe shall not be eligible for payment of unemployment  
8 compensation benefits for any weeks of unemployment during which  
9 the employe is incarcerated after a conviction.

10 (b) The department shall utilize any reasonable means  
11 determined necessary by the secretary to identify and prevent  
12 the payment of benefits to incarcerated individuals who are  
13 disqualified under this section. At a minimum, the means shall  
14 include a cross-check of county prison inmate records with  
15 records kept by the department of current benefit recipients. An  
16 expense incurred under this subsection is hereby declared to be  
17 an administrative expense to be paid from the Administrative  
18 Fund.
