18 (a) General rule.--Suspension of a correctional officer
19 shall be in accordance with provisions of the act of August 5,
20 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), known as the Civil Service Act, except
21 as follows:

22 (1) No suspension based on a pending internal
23 investigation shall last more than 60 days from the effective
24 date of suspension.

25 (2) Written notice of suspension shall be provided to
26 the corrections officer no later than five working days after
27 the effective date of suspension.

28 (3) Medical benefits and insurance shall continue during
29 the period of suspension.
