Clara Barton Memorial Bridge. 8 (a) Findings.--9 In 1882, after years of work, pioneer nurse Clara (1) 10 Barton's organization, the American National Red Cross, was 11 officially established. 12 (2) On June 5, 1889, approximately five days after the 13 South Fork Dam broke in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, Clara Barton 14 and a group of Red Cross volunteers rode the train to the 15 devastated town to help the survivors in one of the first 16 major disaster responses for the organization. 17 (3) Clara Barton and the Red Cross remained in the town 18 for more than five months and provided aid to more than 19 25,000 people by establishing feeding stations, building shelters and rendering medical care. 20 21 (4) Clara Barton continued her work with the Red Cross 22 helping others during times of disaster until her resignation 23 in 1904 at 83 years of age. She died April 12, 1912, at 90 24 years of age. 25 Designation. -- The bridge located on State Route 3023, (b) 26 Johns Street, over Little Conemaugh River in Johnstown, Cambria 27 County is hereby designated the Clara Barton Memorial Bridge. 28 Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and (C) 29 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge. 30 Amend Bill, page 4, line 7, by striking out "4" and inserting 31 32 5
