A building or structure, including a 23 24 covered bridge, which: 25 (1) has been in existence for more than 100 years, 26 including partial or complete reconstruction of a building or 27 structure originally erected at least 100 years ago; or (2) has been listed on the National Register of Historic 28 <u>Places or the Pennsylvania Register of Historic Places.</u> 29 "Occupied structure." Any structure, vehicle or place 30 31 adapted for overnight accommodation of persons or for carrying

1 on business therein, whether or not a person is actually 2 present. If a building or structure is divided into separately 3 occupied units, any unit not occupied by the actor is an 4 occupied structure of another. "Property of another." (a) Mandatory sentence. -- Any person who commits a violation 15 of 18 Pa.C.S. § 3301(a.2) (relating to arson and related 16 offenses) shall be sentenced to a minimum sentence of at least_ 17 18 one year of total confinement. (b) Proof at sentencing. -- Notice of the provisions of this 19 20 <u>section to the defendant shall not be required prior to</u> conviction, but reasonable notice of the Commonwealth's 21 22 <u>intention to proceed under this section shall be provided after</u>

23 <u>conviction and before sentencing.</u>
