1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 31, by inserting after "Fund"

2 ; in 2013-2014 budget implementation, further providing
3 for executive offices; lapsing certain funds; and making
4 an appropriation

5 Amend Bill, page 5, by inserting between lines 19 and 20

6 Section 2. Section 1712-H of the act, repealed and added
7 July 18, 2013 (P.L.574, No.71), is amended to read:
8 Section 1712-H. Executive Offices.

9 (1) Funds appropriated to the Pennsylvania Commission on
10 Crime and Delinquency for intermediate punishment treatment
11 programs shall be distributed competitively to counties for
12 offenders sentenced to intermediate punishment programs. The
13 portion of funds for drug and alcohol treatment shall be
14 based on national statistics that identify the percentage of
15 incarcerated individuals that are in need of treatment for
16 substance issues but in no case shall be less than 80% of the
17 amount appropriated.

18 (2) From funds appropriated to the commission, at least
19 \$285,000 shall be used to support the Statewide Automated
20 Victim Information and Notification System (SAVIN) to provide
21 offender information through county jails and \$200,000 shall
22 be used for a residential treatment community facility for
23 at-risk youth located in a county of the fifth class.

24 (3) From funds appropriated for violence prevention
25 programs, at least \$250,000 shall be used for programs in a
26 city of the second class, and at least \$450,000 shall be used
27 for programs in a city of the first class.

28 (4) From funds appropriated to the Office of
29 Administration for a pilot program to allow for the purchase
30 of technology and related equipment which shall primarily be
31 used at outdoor events to ensure the public's safety, the
32 Office of Administration shall enter into an interagency
33 agreement or memorandum of understanding with the
34 Pennsylvania State Police, the Office of Homeland Security
35 within the Governor's Office or the Pennsylvania National
36 Guard, or any combination thereof, for the purpose of such
37 pilot program.

1 Section 3. The allocation of \$1,500,000 appropriated to the
2 Pennsylvania State Police in section 224 of the act of June 30,
3 2013 (P.L. ____, No. 1A), known as the General Appropriation Act
4 of 2013, for the purpose of a pilot program to allow for the
5 purchase of technology and related equipment which shall
6 primarily be used at outdoor events to ensure the public's
7 safety, shall lapse immediately.

8 Section 4. The sum of \$1,500,000 is hereby appropriated from
9 the General Fund to the Office of Administration for the purpose
10 of a pilot program to allow for the purchase of technology and
11 related equipment which shall primarily be used at outdoor
12 events to ensure the public's safety.
