

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1182

1 Amend Bill, page 45, by inserting between lines 26 and 27  
2 "Medical cannabis study." The Commonwealth-sanctioned  
3 medical cannabis study involving children with epilepsy in each  
4 of the Commonwealth's designated health care facilities.

5 Amend Bill, page 47, line 1, by striking out "ANY OF THE  
6 FOLLOWING," and inserting

7 Epilepsy and seizures,

8 Amend Bill, page 47, line 2, by striking out the colon after  
9 "TREATMENT" and inserting a period

10 Amend Bill, page 47, lines 3 through 14, by striking out all  
11 of said lines

12 Amend Bill, page 47, by inserting between lines 17 and 18

13 Section 103. Use permitted.

14 Notwithstanding any other law, an individual with epilepsy  
15 may use a medical cannabis strain and shall not be subject to  
16 detrimental action, including arrest, prosecution, penalty,  
17 denial of a right or privilege, civil penalty or disciplinary  
18 action by a professional licensing board.

19 Section 104. Secretary of Health.

20 The Secretary of Health of the Commonwealth shall, upon  
21 conclusion of the medical cannabis study, transmit notice of  
22 that fact and whether or not the study demonstrates no medical  
23 benefit derives from the use of medical cannabis or the study is  
24 inconclusive to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication  
25 as a notice in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. If the outcome of the  
26 medical cannabis study demonstrates no medical benefit or is  
27 inconclusive, then qualified medical conditions shall not  
28 include epilepsy and seizures.
