5 Section 1. Section 412.2(a) of the act of June 3, 1937
6 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,
7 amended May 12, 2006 (P.L.178, No.45), is amended and the
8 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

9 Section 412.2. Compensation of District Election Officers.--

10 (a) [In] Prior to January 1, 2017, and thereafter for the
11 purposes of calculations in subsection (c), in all counties
12 regardless of class, the compensation of judges of election,
13 inspectors of election, clerks and machine operators shall be
14 fixed by the county board of elections for each election in
15 accordance with the following:

16 Election Officers	17 Minimum	18 Maximum
	Compensation	Compensation
19 Judges of election	\$75	\$200
20 Inspectors of election	\$75	\$195
21 Clerks and machine operators	\$70	\$195

22 (a.1) Beginning January 1, 2017, in all counties regardless
23 of class, the compensation of judges of election, inspectors of
24 election, clerks and machine operators shall be established at
25 the discretion of the county board of elections under subsection
26 (c) or shall be fixed by the county board of elections for each
27 election in accordance with the following, whichever is greater:

28 Election Officers	29 Hourly Wage
30 <u>Judges of election</u>	<u>\$10.10 per hour</u>
31 <u>Inspectors of election</u>	<u>\$10.10 per hour</u>
32 <u>Clerks and machine operators</u>	<u>\$10.10 per hour</u>
