6 Section 5. Section 1204 of the act, amended October 21, 1965
7 (P.L.601, No.312), is amended to read:

8 Section 1204. Granting Provisional College Certificates.--
9 The [Superintendent of Public Instruction] Secretary of
10 Education may grant a provisional college certificate to every
11 person who presents to [him] the Department of Education
12 satisfactory evidence of good moral character, and of being a
13 graduate of an approved college or university, who has completed
14 such work in education as may be required by the standards of
15 the State Board of Education, and to every person who presents
16 to [him] the Department of Education satisfactory evidence of
17 good moral character, and of being a graduate of music, with the
18 degree of bachelor of music of an approved college or
19 university, who has during such musical course completed the
20 prescribed number of hours of professional studies, which
21 certificate shall entitle [him] the individual to teach for
22 three annual school terms, and may be renewed for one additional
23 three-year period in accordance with standards to be established
24 by the State Board of Education.

25 Section 6. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

26 Section 1204.2. Provisional Vocational Education
27 Certificate.--The Secretary of Education may grant a provisional
28 vocational education certificate to every person who presents to
29 the Department of Education satisfactory evidence of good moral
30 character, and who has completed such work in vocational
31 education as may be required by the standards of the State Board
32 of Education, which certificate shall entitle the individual to
33 teach for eight annual school terms.
