1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 14, by striking out all of said line

17 (9) Notwithstanding any provision of law, regulation or
18 rule to the contrary, beginning January 1, 2016, and if
19 requested by a member of the Judiciary Committee of the
20 Senate or a member of the Judiciary Committee of the House of
21 Representatives, prepare a fiscal analysis for each proposed
22 State or local rule of court as proposed by the Supreme Court
23 of the Commonwealth which projects or proposes an increase or
24 decrease in Commonwealth expenditures for operations of the
25 unified judicial system. The fiscal analysis shall be
26 published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin and shall include, but
27 not be limited to, an analysis of the following:

28 (i) Whether the proposed court rule would increase
29 or decrease the cost of administration of justice for the
30 unified judicial system.

31 (ii) The effect the proposed rule would have on the
32 administration of justice.

33 (iii) Any other financial data or information the

1 office deems appropriate to determine the impact of the
2 proposed rule on Commonwealth revenue and expenditures of
3 the unified judicial system.

4 (iv) Any projected cost savings or increases that
5 may result from adoption and implementation of the
6 proposed rule, if any.

7 (v) Projected return on investment that may result
8 from adoption and implementation of the proposed rule.

9 (vi) An estimate of the fiscal impact of the
10 proposed rule on Commonwealth revenue.
