19 Section 301. Games of chance permitted.
20 [Every] (a) General rule.--Except as otherwise provided in
21 subsection (b), every eligible organization to which a license
22 has been issued under the provisions of this chapter may conduct
23 games of chance for the purpose of raising funds for public
24 interest purposes. Except as provided in Chapter 5, all proceeds
25 of a licensed eligible organization shall be used exclusively
26 for public interest purposes, for the purchase of games of
27 chance or for the payment of the license fee, as required by
28 this act. An eligible organization whose primary purpose is the
29 promotion of a public interest may utilize the proceeds from
30 small games of chance to fulfill that purpose.

1 (b) Exception.--An event game may only be operated by a
2 licensed eligible organization that:
3 (1) is an association as defined in section 3 of the act
4 of July 10, 1981 (P.L.214, No.67), known as the Bingo Law;
5 and
6 (2) holds a bingo license issued to the association
7 under section 5 of the Bingo Law.
